OFFICE ORDER

As part of the requirements for the Bamboo Plantation 2026–27, procurement of quality bamboo saplings is required for plantation activities across the State. Accordingly, as per the guidelines of the National Bamboo Mission (NBM), local nurseries and entrepreneurs having the potential to supply bamboo saplings are required to be verified by the technical agency.

In this regard, Dr. Abhinav Kant, In-charge and Coordinator of Bamboo and Cane Development Institute, along with officials from the Meghalaya State Bamboo Mission (MSBM), conducted field visits and verification of the nurseries listed in the Annexures enclosed below.

Therefore, all District Nodal Officers of MSBM are hereby directed to coordinate with the listed local entrepreneurs and nurseries under their respective districts, undertake necessary field visits, and initiate the required follow-up process for procurement and plantation activities.

The detailed nursery verification reports are enclosed herewith as Annexures for reference and necessary action.



Remarks on Nursery Operations	<p>The nursery is newly established and is currently in the early stages of operational development. During verification, it was observed that the nursery had procured bamboo saplings from external suppliers without adequate verification or identification of the species. As a result, there appears to be uncertainty regarding the authenticity and classification of certain bamboo species provided by the supplier.</p> <p>Additionally, the saplings of different bamboo species were found to be mixed together without proper segregation or labeling, which may create challenges in species identification, stock management, and future plantation planning. Proper tagging, segregation, and documentation of bamboo species are recommended for improved nursery management and traceability.</p>

Overall Recommendation	Upon verification, <i>Bambusa tulda</i> (Tulda Bamboo) was not identified in the nursery; therefore, procurement of Tulda planting materials from this nursery cannot be recommended.




Additionally, some other saplings were observed to be underdeveloped and smaller in size, making them presently unsuitable for plantation purposes.

Remarks on Nursery Operations	<p>During the verification, it was observed that the proprietor has limited practical experience in bamboo plantation and nursery management. The proprietor stated that the macro-propagation techniques being practiced were self-learned through online sources, without formal technical training or guidance.</p> <p>It was further observed that the nursery maintenance practices were not adequately managed. Several otherwise healthy bamboo saplings had rooted directly into the soil due to improper nursery bed preparation and maintenance, which may affect their suitability for transplantation. Additionally, a number of saplings were found to be undersized and not yet suitable for plantation purposes.</p> <p>The nursery would benefit from technical guidance and improved management practices related to species handling, nursery bed preparation, propagation techniques, and overall stock maintenance.</p>



Remarks on Nursery Operations	<p>1. Khardang: During verification, discrepancies were observed regarding the ownership and proprietorship of the nursery. The nursery signboard displayed "Momin Nursery" with Mr. Sunny Roagers as the proprietor, whereas representatives of Sylva R Sangma Nursery claimed ownership of the nursery. However, the tenancy agreement submitted was issued under the name of Sylva R Sangma. Further clarification regarding the ownership and operational authority is recommended. The bamboo saplings were identified as <i>Bambusa tulda</i> (Tulda Bamboo) and were found to be healthy, with good height and suitable growth for plantation.</p> <p>2. Dangkong, Wageasi: During verification, the nursery management was unable to physically produce the land ownership or lease agreement documents on the day of inspection. However, a photograph copy of the MoA for the lease agreement bearing an e-stamp was shared later via WhatsApp and may require further verification. The nursery was found to be well maintained, including proper management of the mother bed and planting materials. The bamboo saplings were identified as <i>Bambusa tulda</i> (Tulda Bamboo) and were healthy, well-grown, and suitable for plantation.</p>

Overall Recommendation	The verified saplings available at the site may be procured with caution. The concerned District team is advised to conduct a follow-up inspection one week prior to procurement to reassess the condition, suitability, and availability of the saplings.




Remarks on Nursery Operations	<p>YEMCS Nursery has recently initiated bamboo plantation activities. During verification, the nursery management stated that approximately 300 kg of <i>Bambusa tulda</i> (Tulda Bamboo) seeds were procured for propagation; however, only 11 nursery beds of saplings were observed during inspection, indicating a comparatively low germination and survival rate.</p> <p>The overall nursery condition and maintenance were found to be below satisfactory standards, with inadequate nursery bedding and bed preparation practices. The saplings were in moderate condition, with many leaves showing yellowing, browning, and signs of decay. Improved nursery management and technical supervision are recommended to enhance sapling health and survival.</p>



Remarks on Nursery Operations	A. Maiong Nursery was found to be very well maintained during verification, with properly developed nursery beds and pavements. The nursery operates across three nearby locations. The nursery management stated that approximately 30 kg of <i>Bambusa tulda</i> (Tulda Bamboo) seeds were provided by MSBM, resulting in over 40,000 saplings, with an additional 10,000 saplings propagated by the nursery, bringing the total stock to around 50,000 saplings. The nursery also procured approximately 60 kg of <i>Bambusa tulda</i> seeds from Tripura, from which over 100,000 saplings were reportedly raised. The saplings were found to be healthy, well maintained, and suitable for plantation. Minor leaf infections showing white dot patches were observed in some saplings; however, the issue was not found to be severe.

Overall Recommendation	The verified <i>Bambusa tulda</i> (Tulda Bamboo) saplings available at the site may be recommended for procurement, subject to the availability of approximately 1,50,000 healthy saplings suitable for plantation. The concerned District team is advised to conduct a follow-up inspection one week prior to procurement to verify the total availability of saplings.



During inspection, the seeds procured from Assam, initially believed to be <i>Bambusa tulda</i> (Tulda Bamboo), were identified as <i>Dendrocalamus longispathus</i> . The nursery infrastructure and maintenance were found to be satisfactory; however, the condition of the saplings was below optimum standards. Most saplings were of moderate size, with dry leaves showing yellow patches and signs of decay. Improved nursery and plant health management practices are recommended.

Overall Recommendation	<i>Bambusa tulda</i> (Tulda Bamboo) was not identified during verification; therefore, procurement of Tulda saplings from this nursery is not recommended.
